

## Indoor Worship Service Guidelines (updated 10/9/2020)

- Arrival: Please enter the building through the Kingdom Kid's entrance facing the parking lot. A greeter will welcome you and hand you a bulletin, if desired. Bulletins may also be found [on our website](#) if you prefer to print your own or follow on your device.
- Chairs are set up in the sanctuary to accommodate families sitting together. Groups of chairs are spaced at least six feet apart between family groups. Families are asked to sit together, stay together, and to respect physical distancing while inside the building. Overflow seating will be available in the foyer, if needed.
- All doors to the sanctuary will remain open as will some main doors into the building for better airflow.
- Out of consideration for the well-being of all attending and in an effort to exercise the debt of love and show charity in our liberty (Romans 13:8-14:23), we are asking all who are able to wear a face covering while indoors. We understand that exceptions are reasonable for young children and those with breathing conditions such as asthma, etc. Please put on your face covering before entering the building.
- We are not able to provide a nursery or children's programs at this time. Children will remain with their parents during the entire service. We will have two Kingdom Kids rooms designated for parents with very young children who may want to sit with them outside of the sanctuary and watch/listen to the service. Arrangements can be made ahead of time by [emailing the office](#).
- We ask that you limit restroom use as much as possible but they will be available if needed. Parents must accompany young children to the restrooms.
- An offering box will be available at the greeter table to drop off tithes and offerings, or you can continue to give online or by mail.
- Coffee, refreshments and water fountain use will not be available at this time.
- Following the service, we ask all families to immediately exit through the back doors of the sanctuary and out the main entrance in an orderly fashion, continuing to respect physical distancing between families. All fellowship before and after the service should take place outside the building.
- Additional Precautions: People should refer to CDC guidelines regarding taking extra precautions in considering whether you should attend worship or stay at home and worship online.

Please note YOU SHOULD NOT ATTEND IF:

- You or anyone in your family is sick or have COVID-like symptoms currently or in the past two weeks.
- If in the past two weeks, you or anyone in your family has come in contact with someone who has had a confirmed case of COVID-19 or you have reasonable cause to suspect you've been exposed.
