Thank you, O God, for Your forgiveness through Christ. Father, be glorified above all things in our worship. Lord Jesus, fill us with your love and joy that we might be conformed to Your image. Holy Spirit, unite us in the truth, that we might be stirred up to love and good deeds and encourage one another in godliness. We humbly pray this in Jesus' name, Amen.

Heidelberg Catechism Q. 1

We receive God's promise in his word of his forgiveness for sin and the blessings of eternal life in Christ Jesus.
